Myxozoa occasionally cause disease in amphibians and result in specific host/disease agent lesions. Treatment efforts are focused on providing supportive care. Metazoa parasites include myxozoa, helminths, and arthropods. Myxozoa infections in amphibians generally do not cause mortality.

The zoonotic diseases associated with reptile and amphibian contact are primarily bacterial infections.
