What to Do When Your Child Is a Perfectionist

You can help your child understand the power of yet by using the following 3-STEP STRATEGY: When your child is ready to work on a task, ask to create a draft or a prototype first. This allows your child to try, learn from his errors, revise, and improve. When she completes a draft, acknowledge what he has done well.
