The regulations state that an employer must: Avoid the need for hazardous manual handling, so far as is reasonably practicable

The Manual Handling Operations Regulations 1992, as amended by the Health and Safety (Miscellaneous Amendments) Regulations 2002 set out guidance to help you manage, control and reduce the risk of injury from manual handling. The Regulations apply to manual handling activities involving the transporting or supporting of loads, including lifting, lowering, pushing, pulling, carrying or moving loads.

### Manual Handling Operations Regulations

The Manual Handling Operations Regulations require an employer to carry out a risk assessment on all manual handling tasks that pose an injury risk. Employees have a duty to take reasonable care of their own health and safety and that of others who may be affected by their actions. They must communicate with their employers so that they too are able to meet their health and safety duties. The Regulations define Manual Handling as:

### The Manual Handling Operations Regulations 1992

The Manual Handling Operations Regulations require employers to avoid, assess and reduce the risk of injury from manual handling.

The Manual Handling Operations Regulations established a hierarchy of measures that an employer must take into account when a manual handling activity is being undertaken and presents a hazard. These measures state that manual handling operations should be avoided as far as possible.

### Manual handling at work: Overview - HSE

The manual handling operations regulations apply to nearly all UK organisations in all sectors, with very few exceptions. It also has reach outside the UK for certain activities. The regulations cover all activities that involve "the transporting or supporting of loads, including lifting, lowering, pushing, pulling, carrying or moving".
