Based on the response of the teeth with SRA that were bonded, the exposure and orthodontic traction of the impacted teeth and bonding of the control teeth with SRA would be planned. The second option involved the use of temporary anchorage device-supported traction of the impacted teeth with delayed bonding of other teeth along with minimal orthodontics for aligning and finishing.

Orthodontic: To retract upper and lower anterior teeth, distalize upper arch, align, and establish occlusion. Treatment alternatives. One option proposed to the patient was exclusive restorative or prosthodontic treatment. This would entail heavy reduction of tooth tissue or extraction of teeth. In addition, it could possibly incur higher costs.
