Gabapentin (10 mg/kg, PO, bid) is a calcium channel blocker used to inhibit neurons stimulated by pain; it is useful for treatment of animals with chronic or neuropathic pain. Dexmedetomidine (5 mcg/kg/day, IM) and medetomidine (10 mcg/kg/day, IM) are newer analgesic-sedative, $\alpha 2$ -receptor blocking agents useful to facilitate examinations or diagnostic evaluations.

A pain scale is one tool that veterinarians can use to rate an animal's pain. A pain score is obtained using a questionnaire that includes the following information: species, breed, age, gender, environment and living conditions, cause of pain (such as trauma or surgery), body region affected (such as the abdomen or muscle), and the duration and intensity of pain.
